### **Accumulation of Points**

Junior Handlers can accumulate points for earning legs in events throughout the year. A Junior Handler may only obtain points for legs earned with a PRT, however, a Junior Handler may accumulate points for more than one PRT over the course of a year.

### **Determination of the Junior Handler of the Year**

The Junior Handler accumulating the most points over the course of a year will be awarded the title of "PRTAA Junior Handler of the Year." In the event of a tie, the award will be shared. Due to the short nature of a Junior's eligibility before they age out of the program and to promote good sportsmanship, with fair opportunity to all, the number of times that any given Junior will be allowed to win the award is limited to three.
