

Earth Dog Breeder Hall of Fame - Fee \$10.00 payable to the PRTAA or Paypal Account

The Earth dog Breeder Hall of Fame Award is intended to reward those breeders of the PRT who breed with the intent of keeping the dog true to its roots. Breeders who have bred dogs that have demonstrated the instinct and conformation necessary to work below ground by earning PRTAA earthwork medals or AKC earth dog titles will earn the award when they have reached a level of excellence through points accumulated by the dogs they have bred.

Points Accumulation

Earthwork Titles

1st Working Certificate = 5 Points

2nd Working Certificate = 4 Points

Total of 3 Working Certificates to different quarry = 8 Points

Earth Dog Titles

JE = 3 Points



SE = 4 Points

ME = 8 Points

Endurance Earth dog = 15 points

Iron Dog Legs = 2 points each
